This is your opportunity to highlight some of your best work and a chance for you and your agency to be recognized on an international level. The category breakdown is as follows:

Tactical Crime Bulletins

Bulletins that were created for use by patrol and detective divisions to aid in solving a tactical crime series. This includes crime pattern and suspect information, and is generally 2 pages or less.



Crime and Intelligence Charting

This category includes all link charts, timelines, flowcharts, and other investigative and intelligence based tools. Data may include but is not limited to cash flow, known associations, phone toll, and covert operations analysis.

Crime Maps

All maps that represent a crime series or trend. Other aspects of analysis may be incorporated, but the map should be the main focus of this product.



Statistical / Information Reports

This includes crime based daily, weekly, or monthly reports, or reports that are a summation of a case in which crime analysis was involved. These are usually several pages, and strategic / administrative in nature.

All submissions must be received on or before August 31st, 2007. Entries must be submitted by email to bulletincontest@iaca.net. Judges will be looking for the best quality presentation of data, to include grammar, punctuation, spelling and neatness. Analysis must be a part of the bulletin, not just presentation of data. The author must be a member of either IACA or CCIAA in order to submit and entry, and the product must have been created by you between Oct 2006 and July 2007. Limit of one entry per person. Please attach your name and contact information, along with which category you are wish to enter. Confidential information should be blacked out.
