## Garage Door Opener Thefts/Residential Burglary Crime Series

Detectives across the metro area have been tracking a series of similar occurrences of residential burglaries that were proceeded by the victim having their garage door opener stolen from their vehicle at a commercial location. More than a dozen instances of this MO have been reported in Leawood, Mission Hills, Merriam, Overland Park, Kansas City (MO), and Prairie Village.

Suspects have been developed in this case. Leads point to **NAME #1, R/S, DOB** and **NAME #2, R/S, DOB**. *Name #1* is in custody on an Overland Park Feb. 14 residential burglary charge. *Name #2* may be driving a **Vehicle Description #1**

Others subjects associated to these suspects in assisting on the burglaries or pawning stolen property include:

**NAME #3, R/S, DOB** of **Address**, whose residence was called by the suspects from a stolen cell phone during the crime spree, had a stolen **Vehicle Description #2** with stolen plate parked in the driveway of her house. The vehicle was stolen from a dealership in January, 2000. Some of the property recovered from the vehicle was reported stolen in several residential burglaries where the garage door opener had been stolen. In addition, property from a stolen **Vehicle Description #3** (possibly driven by *Name#1*) was recovered from the vehicle. The Vehicle was stolen from a gas station at *Gas Station Name/Location* where it was left running.

**NAME #4, R/S, DOB, Address** pawned items from a Merriam burglary.

**NAME #7, R/S, DOB, Address**, is a friend of *Name #2* and pawned items at **BUSINESS** on Wornall from the Leawood burglary.

On Feb. 14, a **Vehicle Description #4**, stolen out of Prairie Village, was observed backing out of the driveway of a residence at *Location* (Overland Park). The victim reported her garage door opener was stolen at *the Business name*. A residence check was being conducted by OPPD when the suspects were observed. A suspect was developed and arrested. The investigation revealed a positive identification of *Name #1* driving the *Vehicle #4*. *Name #1* was arrested at his place of employment, **BUSINESS** in *City* on Feb. 18.

A known associate of *Name #3* is **NAME #5, R/S, DOB**. *Name #5* has been contacted at **address** and is known to associate at the residence.

On 02/15/00 at 0900 hours, KCMO officers stopped **NAME #6, R/S, DOB, description, Address**. *Name #6* is *Name #1's* brother. *Name #6* had on his person a stolen *Vehicle Description #2* key taken from **CAR DEALERSHIP NAME** in January.

A search warrant was conducted at the *Name #3* residence. Recovered in the search warrant was a stolen shotgun from a PV burglary. Several power tools, stolen identification cards/credit cards, and checks from auto thefts and purse snatches in the Metro Area were recovered.
