


- We delivered 62 total training sessions in English and Spanish to 5,706 students from 72 different countries.
- 25 analysts from Dominican Republic trained in Spanish Fundamentals course.
- The webinar series for 2022 was a review of the Certification skill sets for LEAF and CLEA with 12 separate sessions covering all 19 chapters. All 12 (over 15 hours long!) are available in the webinar library for members.
- The webinar library now has over 125 videos available on demand and is now grouped by series and we are adding class materials wherever possible.
- We've started awarding Continuing Education credits to all IACA members for training in lieu of certificates (still provided on demand). Awarded for future classes and we are back-filling historical data slowly but surely. More information is available in the Training FAQs on the website.






Classes Taught Per Year, 2006-current, by Type
