**Anyone.** No previous experience is necessary, but the class will also be useful to analysts who have a few years of experience.

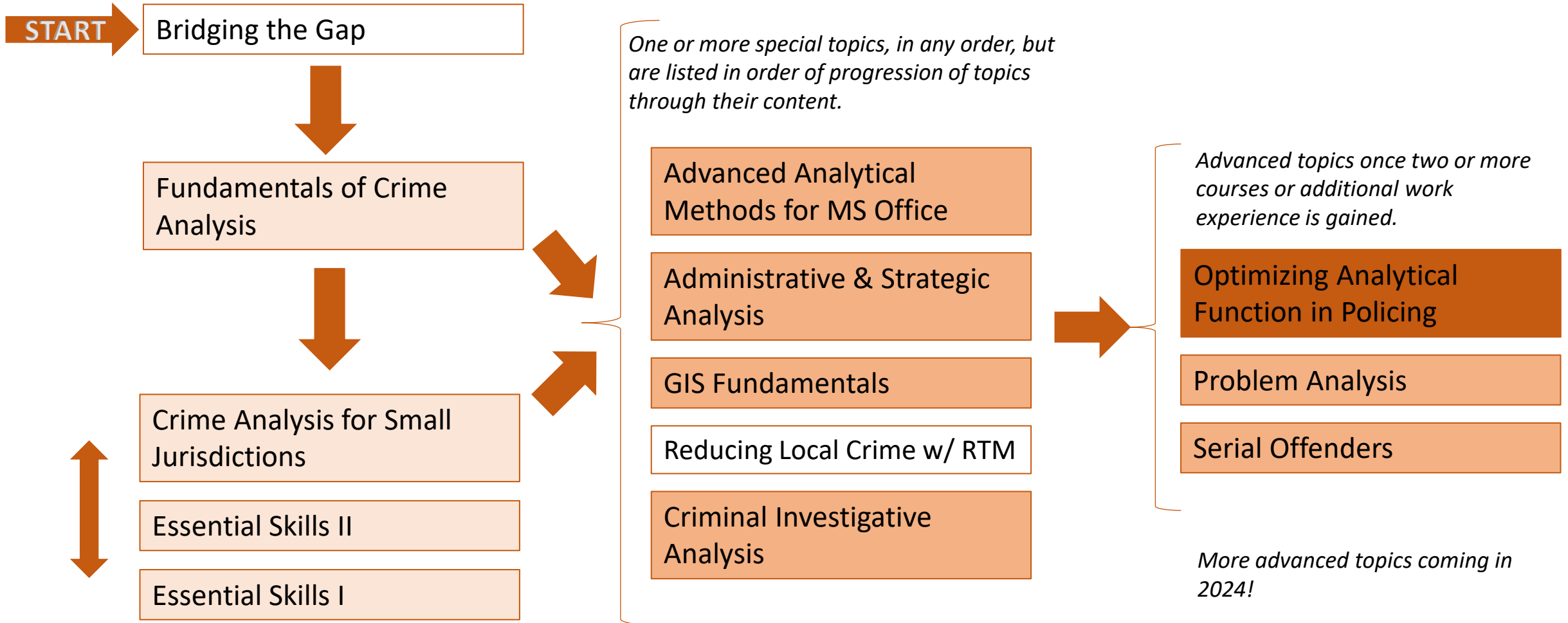
**Beginner.** No experience as an analyst is necessary.
