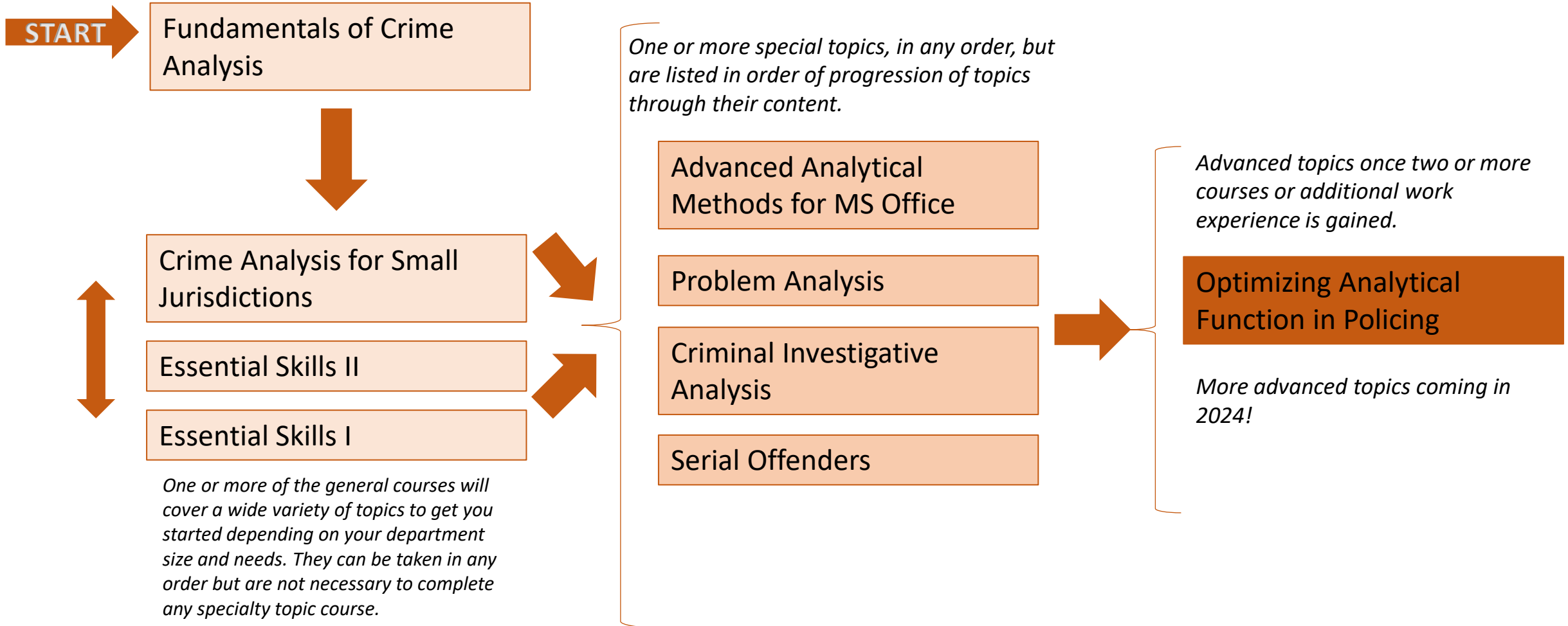
Anyone. *No previous experience is necessary, but the class will also be useful to analysts who have a few years of experience.*
